
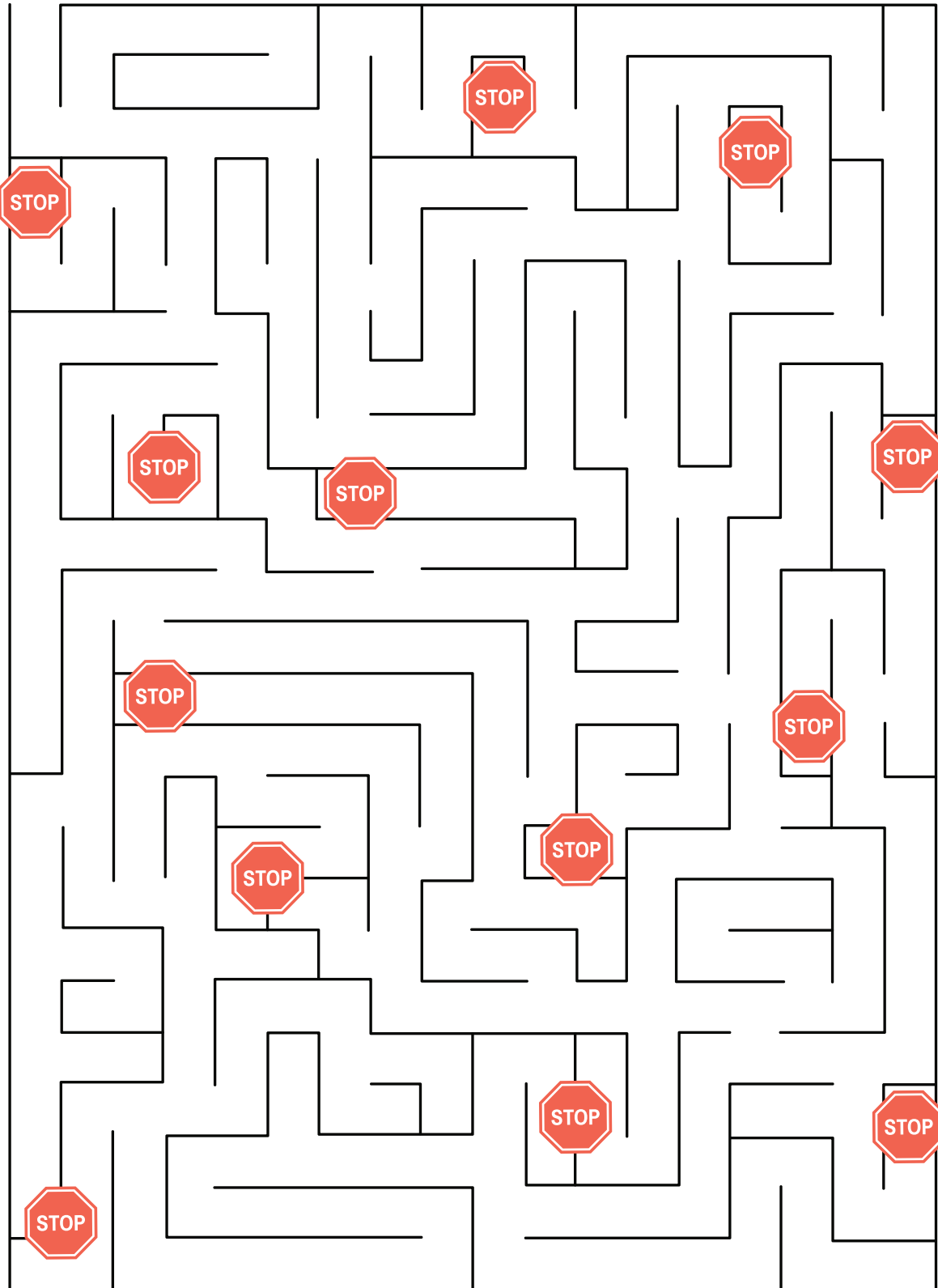


Check First!
